Touch the correct button.

Touch the correct date.

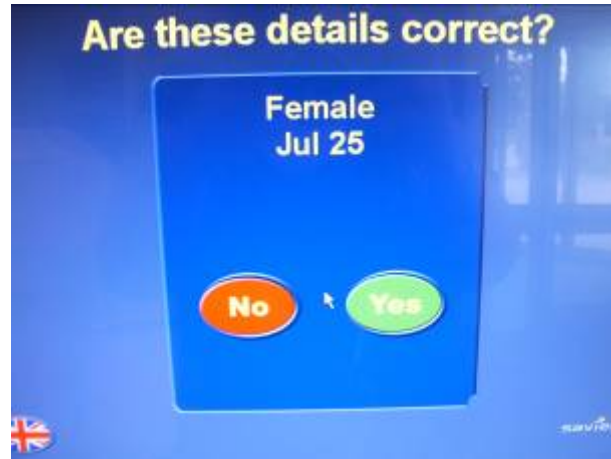

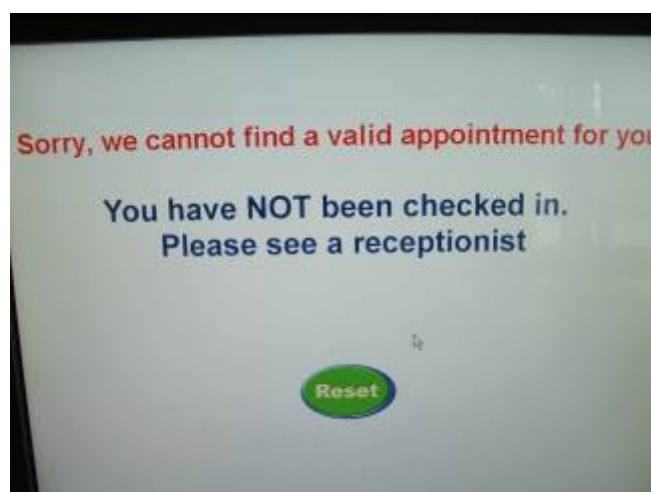
## Using the Touch Screen at the Doctor's Surgery

If they are **correct** touch the **YES** button  
If they are **wrong** touch the **NO** button and start again.

6. The screen will now tell you **who** your appointment is with and **what time** it will be.



If there is a **problem** the screen will tell you to go and see the receptionist who will book you in.
