Entry Level 3

Play the game like concentration (pelmanism, pairs) in small groups. The one with the most pairs wins. Learners can either match pairs of homophones only (omit the definition cards) or match each word to its meaning. Tutor can remove difficult words / definitions as needed to suit the level of the group.

Level 1-2

Start as above but when a learner has found a pair of homophones they run to the front of the class, find the correct definition cards and blu tack them to the board or wall. First group to finish wins.
