Comments:		

The **2010 FIFA (this stands for the Federation Internationale de Football Association) World Cup** will be the 19th FIFA World Cup, the most important international football tournament. It will take place between 11 June and 11 July 2010 in South Africa. Teams began the qualification process in August 2007 and 204 of the 208 FIFA national teams were involved.



This will be the first time that the tournament has been hosted by an African nation, after South Africa beat Morocco and Egypt in an all-African bidding process. Italy are the defending champions. The draw for the finals took place on 4 December 2009 in Cape Town. As the host nation, South Africa qualified automatically for the tournament.
