



Test Tips



- Use space on the question paper for your rough work. The question booklet isn't marked, so no-one will see it.
- **Don't get stuck on questions you can't answer** – move on and come back to it later if you have time but ...
- ... be careful not to lose your place on your answer sheet. Check that you are marking the right answer box for the question you have just done – it is very easy to be one number out.
- **Don't panic** if you can't do the first few questions. Just move on until you find an easier question.
- Make sure you know how to change your answer on the answer sheet before you start the test.
- The answer sheet is marked by computer, so mark your answers neatly.
- You must fill in the answer sheet within the time allowed – 1¼ hours.
- Make sure you know what time the test will finish – if you're not sure, ask.
- There is no set pattern of how many times a, b, c, or d can be the correct answer.
- Remember there is only ever one correct answer to each question.
- If you really don't know the answer, try to eliminate the less likely choices, one by one.
- Don't worry if other people finish before you – they may be doing a different level of test.
- You are allowed 1¼ hours – use all the time. There aren't any bonus marks for leaving before the time is up.
