TOO

as an amount

1. Too much or too little of something

- **Too** much heat = **too** hot
- Not enough heat so you become **too** cold
- The streets are **too** dark
- **Too** hard / difficult
- **Too** wet / dry
- In the winter there is not enough light or **too** little light
- That child is **too** small for this ride!

Tip

Notice the extra 'o'. There are too many o's.

TOO

also / as well

- I want a cuppa but I think I'll have a cake **too**.
- "Mum said I can come **too**."

Notice the extra 'o'. There is more than one.
