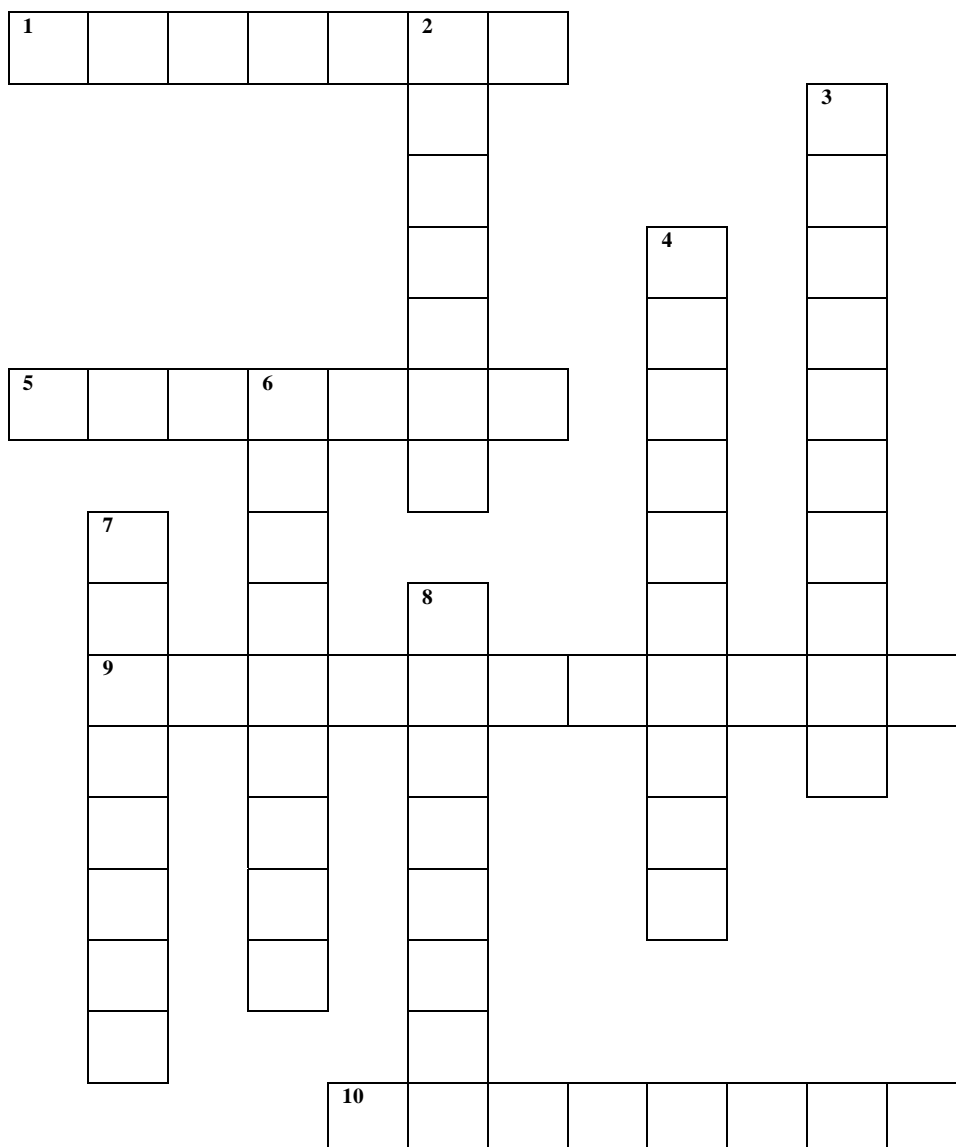
There are about 200 -ible words and it is a closed list. Any new words will always end in -able (e.g. photocopiable, networkable).

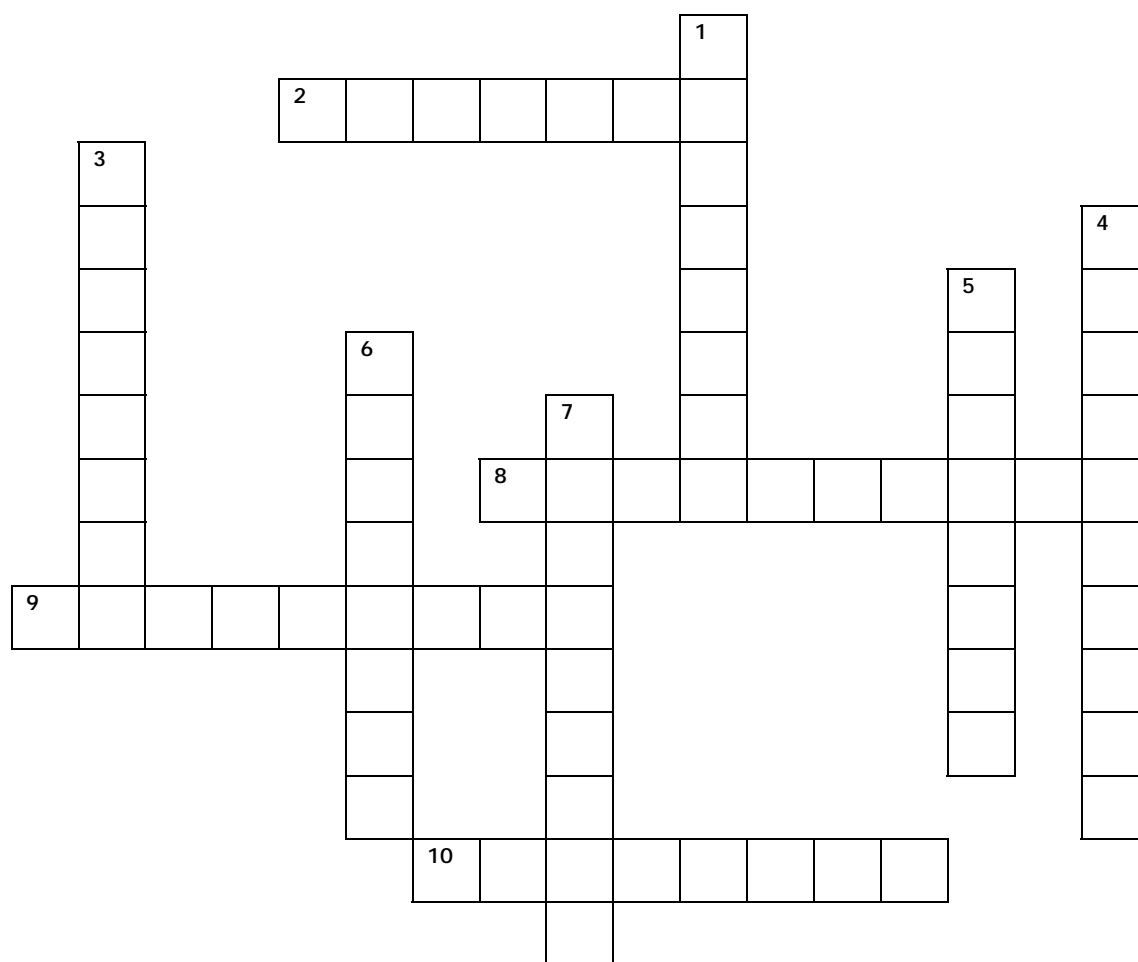
