Author's Instructions

- Cut out the nine bingo boards (pages 1-3) and laminate if possible (you can cut off the pictures far right if you think these too child-like or inappropriate for your learners).
- Arrange students in pairs and each pair can pick a card for their team (I get them to think of a name for their team).
- Cut up the list of words (page 4) and put them in a hat. You can also print an extra copy of this page to use as a master checklist if needed.
- Draw out the words one by one and say them aloud. The students cover the ones they have with counters, scraps of paper or post-it notes. (If the boards are laminated students can cross words out with a dry-wipe pen).
- For E1 learners write the words on the class whiteboards as you call them out, or if you have another tutor he or she could do that.
- You then need a scoring system. I give each team a point for one line, a point for two lines and then 2 points for a full house.
