

Knife crime resources – game cards



These resources were developed to discuss knife crime with parents and children in a family learning setting. They are equally suitable in an FE setting – prompting discussion between students and tutors.

The resources include

- Board game – two A3 sheets (available as a separate document).
- Cards for the board game. These can double up as snap cards (see pages 2-10).
- Timeline exercise (available as a separate document)

The material can be used to focus on knife crime but can also be useful as part of wider discussion about criminal behaviour.

The pictures are meant to stimulate discussion and the game is meant to provide scenarios which can be discussed too. Reading the cards and timelines involves aspects of basic literacy and they also include elements of numeracy. If needed, answers to the questions on the cards can be found using simple internet searching.

The timeline can be cut up and used as a re-ordering exercise and a discussion prompt.

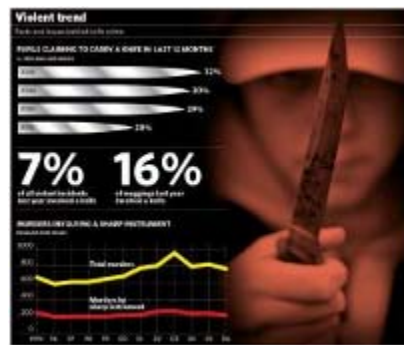


Someone at your school was injured by a knife and you help in a campaign to stop knives. Go forward 3 spaces.
