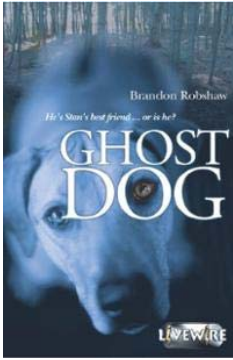


# Ghost Dog Review

I would recommend this book because it was a good story line. It made me want to read on to find out what was going to happen next.

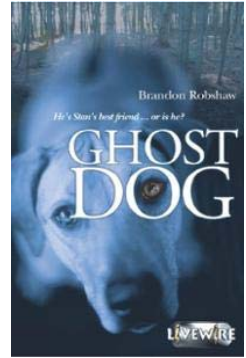
