Teaching notes

Self-explanatory, really.

Learners have to go round and ask each other questions. They write the name of someone who answers 'yes' to complete each sentence on the bingo board. First one to complete shouts "bingo!"

Ensure learners are asking questions and not just writing their names on each other's sheets!

Some of the questions have scope for further discussion which could be done as part of a whole class feedback.

For an extension activity learners could work in groups and think up some more questions, which tutors could use the following year ;). These could have an emphasis on maths, spelling, sentence structure or whatever you wish.

Blank board also provided, feel free to change the topics to suit your learners.
