These words can be copied onto lolly sticks, which you can get in the arts and craft section of supermarkets and large stores. Then label 3 cups with nouns, verbs and adjectives. Learners can work in pairs or small groups to sort the sticks. I've made four sets of these and it's been well worth the effort. They could be printed out and laminated but the lolly sticks are always well-received.

Learners will soon spot that quite a few words can fall into more than one category depending on how they are used. As an extra challenge, ask learners to find the one word which could be all 3. (The answer is **magic**.)

Note: March has to be a noun as it starts with a capital letter, so it is a proper noun.
