### Zero Conditional - This is for real situations

#### <u>If / when + present simple</u>

If I want to contact my friend

When I listen to music

If I study hard

present simple

I use Facebook

I go on YouTube

my teacher is happy



#### First Conditional -This is for possible / likely situations



#### If + present simple

If I play computer games all night If I contact my teacher on Teams If I speak English every day

<u>will + infinitive</u>
<u>I will be</u> tired tomorrow
she will reply to my message
<u>I will improve</u>

### Second Conditional - This is for hypothetical, unreal, unlikely or impossible situations. IT IS NOT FOR THE PAST TENSE



#### If + past simple

#### would + infinitive

If I wanted to research a subject

If I was the Prime Minister

<u>If he won</u> £1 000 000

I would go on Wikipedia I would stop children using social media he would give a lot of money to charity




