

# Follow-me measure cards

<p><b>22 centimetres</b> How many millilitres in one litre?</p>	<p><b>1000 millilitres</b> How many metres in 2 kilometres?</p>
<p><b>2000 metres</b> How many kilograms is 1200grams?</p>	<p><b>1.2kg</b> What is the area of a room with length 3m and width 4m?</p>
<p><b>12 square metres</b> What is a unit of measurement for weight?</p>	<p><b>Grams</b> How many millimetres is 5 centimetres?</p>
<p><b>50 mm</b> How many millilitres in half a litre?</p>	<p><b>500ml</b> What can I use to measure capacity?</p>

# Follow-me measure cards

<p><b>measuring jug</b> How many centilitres in two litres?</p>	<p><b>200cl</b> What is the volume of a box 5cm wide, 10cm long and 3cm deep?</p>
<p><b>150 cm<sup>3</sup></b> What is the width of my fingernail (roughly): 1cm, 1mm or 1m?</p>	<p><b>1cm</b> What is a quarter of a metre in centimetres?</p>
<p><b>25 cm</b> How much glass would you need for a window 1m wide and 1.5m high?</p>	<p><b>1.5 square metres</b> How many centimetres is 220 millimetres?</p>

This worked well as a bit of revision on measuring for a mixed class E2-L2. I've used different colours for easier and harder answers, so you can differentiate when you give the cards out (blue ones are supposed to be a bit easier, red ones a bit harder, and purple in between).
