Wayne Rooney reading task



Wayne Rooney

Wayne Mark Rooney was born on 24th October 1985 in Croxteth, Liverpool. This 24 year old striker is expected to play a huge part in England's progress in the World Cup in South Africa.

He began his playing career at Everton, transferring to Manchester United in 2004 for £25.6 million.

Since joining Manchester United he has won the Premier League three times, the 2007 – 2008 UEFA Champions League and two League Cups. He has been awarded the PFA Players' Player of the Year and the FWA Footballer of the year in 2009 – 2010.

Rooney became the youngest player to play for England when he earned his first cap in a friendly against Australia on 12th February 2003, aged seventeen. He also became the youngest player to score an England goal.

Wayne Rooney is married to Coleen who he met when they were both in their final year at secondary school. Their wedding took place on 12th June 2008 in Italy. Their son, Kai Wayne, was born on 2nd November 2009.
