Author's notes

I developed this game to use in my ESOL classes when talking about health, visiting the doctor and hospital, etc.

While intended for ESOL it could also be used for literacy speaking and listening.

I have included pictures which can be used to develop discussion strands e.g. alcohol and the law, healthy eating / shopping for the family, smoking and diseases, etc.

The page can be laminated and re-used. The tutor can decide on the length of time the person speaks when landing on a picture depending on the level of the student.
