## A Day at the Zoo



You have been given responsibility to take 15 children (aged between 3 and 5 years old) on an outing to the zoo next month. Before going on the outing, you must:

- Decide what day you will go to the zoo, and answer the given questions.
- Show the expected zoo admission costs, putting this information into a table.
- Show the expected travel costs
- You can use a calculator to help you

The following guidelines must be followed:

**Goal:** You have to produce a detailed plan of your trip to the zoo.

**Research:** You must research your trip on the Internet, using any appropriate websites. A list of recommended websites is available.

You are only browsing to find information you are interested in and are **not allowed** to actually purchase anything.

**Accounting:** Record exactly how much money will be spent.



## **Process**

- 1. Decide how many people are going to the zoo. There are 15 children, but how many adults are required for supervision?
- 2. Now you must decide which zoo to visit, and price the tickets. Try to price at least 2 different zoos, and decide which zoo you wish to take the children to visit.
- 3. To price the cost of travel, you must decide on the type of transport you will take. You must price the cost of rail, bus, and hiring a coach to take your party to the zoo of your choice.
- 4. Write a short paragraph on your findings. This should include the name of the zoo, method of transport and cost, zoo admission tickets and any group discounts. Feel free to include any pictures or additional information you have discovered.
- 5. When you have finished, remember to add your name to each sheet and check everything over carefully. Then print your sheets and submit them to your tutor.
