- **How to use these activities.** Please **do not** use these worksheets in isolation, only as part of a well-planned lesson. For example:

In individual work after a group session on the related texts.

Copy on to acetate and project word searches and word shape sheets onto a whiteboard (or use an electronic whiteboard). Encourage students to come to whiteboard and circle or fill-in words.

Enlarge on to A3 and ask students to work in pairs.

Model on whiteboard as above then encourage students to create their own word searches, crosswords, etc.
