

ICT Task sheet:

Cost of items in your toolkit



1. Think about the 10 most essential items you need in your tool kit as a mechanic.
2. Look on the internet, find details of the 10 items, along with their cost.
3. Next, open up a spreadsheet and put together a table showing each tool and its price. Then carry out the following calculations:
 - a) The total cost of all 10 items.
 - b) The mean average cost for one item.
 - c) Add another column, add the same number in each row. This number needs to be the number of people who work in your team at your garage.
 - d) Put the heading “cost for team” and work out the cost for each essential item for the whole team.
 - e) Work out the total cost for your team.
 - f) Format the costs to show currency and decimal places.
 - g) Imagine you are now ordering the tools for you and your team. You find an offer on a website for 15% off when you buy 3 items or more. Now work out the cost of the tools for you and your team with 15% off.
 - h) Include a suitable graph, include titles and a key.
