Local Council Committee Meeting to discuss proposals for The River Streets brownfield land

7.30pm Wednesday 12th October 2022 Birkenhead Town Hall

The Local Council has organised this meeting to discuss and agree upon proposals to develop the area of land known as the 'River Streets' area in Birkenhead. The council sees the development of this area as an important next step in the regeneration of Birkenhead, and is looking to hear a range of viewpoints and opinions on how the land should be used to benefit the community as a whole.

Some proposals so far include a new supermarket, community gardens, a leisure and community centre, and affordable housing. The council is open to hearing other proposals from attendees at the meeting.

The aim of the meeting is to achieve agreement on the best way to develop the land, and so a vote on the best proposal will be held at the end of the meeting.
