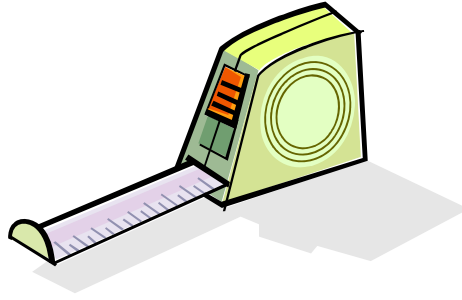

Converting from metres to kilometres



There are 1,000 metres in a kilometre. So, if you want to convert metres to kilometres you need to divide the number of metres by 1,000. Try the following using the calculator and see if you can see the pattern.

- e.g. 4,000m = 4km (4,000 ÷ 1,000 = 4)
- 1,500m = 1.5km (1,500 ÷ 1,000 = 1.5)
- 2,534m = 2.534km (2,534 ÷ 1,000 = 2.534)
- 12,250m = 12.25km (12,250 ÷ 1,000 = 12.25)
