	Ascending	Going up	Start with the smallest 
	Descending	Going down	Start with the largest 
	Overdrawn	Owing the bank money	If you are overdrawn by £10 you owe the bank £10 and your bank balance will be a negative number -£10.00
	Debit card	A card that lets you remove (spend) money from a bank account.	
	>	Greater than	The largest / widest / open side of the symbol is always next to the larger number. E.g. Six is greater than four: $6 > 4$
	<	Less than	Twenty five is less than fifty nine: $25 < 59$
