An upstairs window should only be considered as a last resort.

However, if you are trapped in an upstairs room:

Do not panic.

Stuff any cracks around the doors with clothes.

Signal from the window for help.

If the room is filled with smoke, get down on your hands and knees. There may be a layer of cleaner air at floor level.

Crawl towards the window.

Throw bedding out of the window to cushion your fall.

Climb out of the window and lower yourself as far as you can before dropping.
