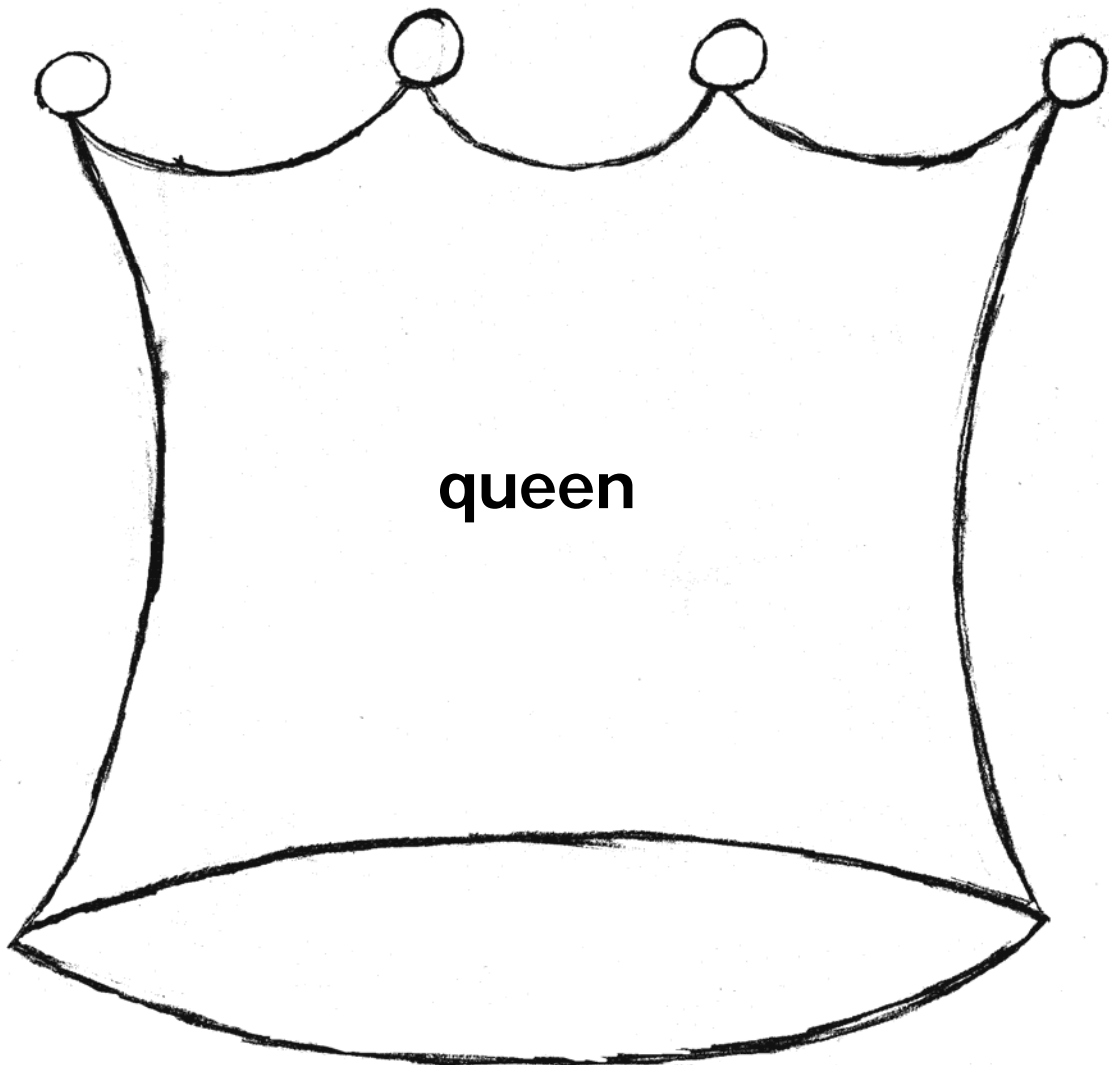

Write the **qu** words in the crown.

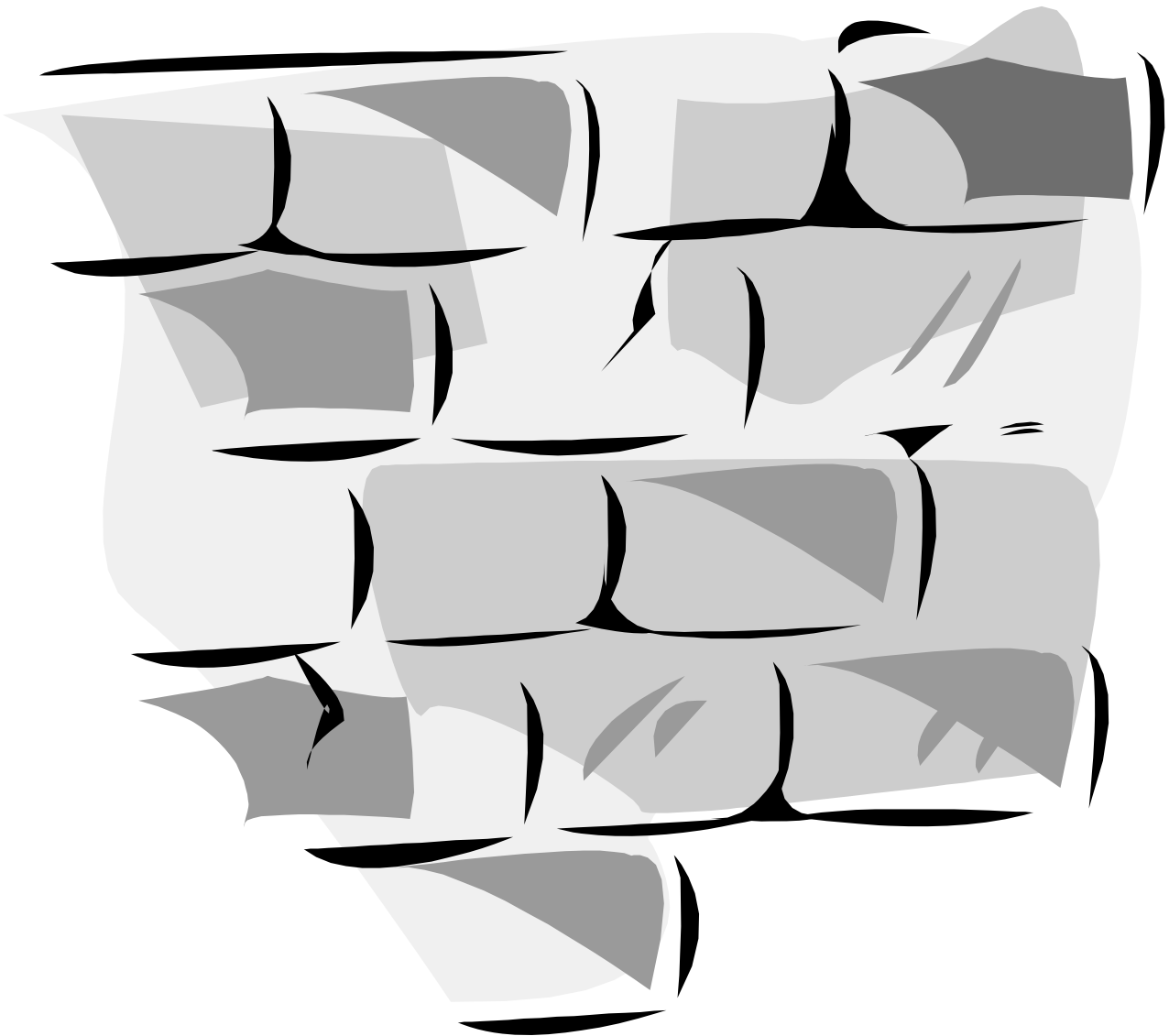
